**MATERIALS**

**Bernat Matrix** (50 g/1.75 oz), **Main Color (MC)**

**Bernat Boa** (50 g/1.75 oz), **Contrast A**

<b>Purple</b>	(02315 Graphic Grape)	(81305 Parrot)
<b>Red</b>	(02530 Radius Red)	(81530 Cardinal)
<b>Orange</b>	(02520 Copper Wire)	(81505 Phoenix)

Sizes	XS	S	M	L	XL	2XL	3XL	
<b>MC</b>	7	7	7	8	8	9	9	<b>balls</b>
<b>A</b>	1	1	1	1	1	1	1	<b>ball</b>

Sizes 4 mm (U.S. 6) and 5.5 mm (U.S. 9) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

**GAUGE:** 24 sts and 34 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] in stocking st with smaller needles and Bernat Matrix.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

*The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ).*

**BACK:** \*\*With A and larger needles, cast on 57 (**65-72-79-86-93-100**) sts. Knit 3 rows. Break A.

Change to smaller needles, MC and proceed as follows:

**Next row:** (RS). (K1. Inc 1 st in next st) 8 (**10-11-12-13-14-15**) times. (Inc 1 st in next st) 27 (**27-30-33-36-39-42**) times. (Inc 1 st in next st. K1) 7 (**9-10-11-12-13-14**) times. 99 (**111-123-135-147-159-171**) sts.

Beg with a purl row, cont in stocking st, until work from beg measures 14 ins [35 cm] ending on a purl row.

**Shape armholes:** Cast off 5 (**7-9-11-13-15**) sts beg next 2 rows. 89 (**97-105-113-121-133-141**) sts.

Dec 1 st each end of needle on next 5 (**7-9-9-11-13-15**) rows, then every following alt row 2 (**3-4-5-5-7-8**) times. 75 (**77-79-85-89-93-95**) sts.\*\*

Cont even until armhole measures 7½ (**8-8½-9-9½-10-10½**) ins [19 (**20.5-21.5-23-24-25.5-26.5**) cm], ending with a purl row.

**Next row:** Cast off 12 (**13-14-17-17-19-20**) sts beg next 2 rows. Cast off rem 51 (**51-51-51-55-55-55**) sts.

**FRONT**

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Back.

Cont even until armhole measures 2½ (**3-3½-4-4½-5-5½**) ins [6 (**7.5-9-10-11.5-12.5-14**) cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

**Shape neck: Next row:** K20 (**21-22-25-25-27-28**) (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a st holder.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 5 rows, then every following alt row 3 times. 12 (**13-14-17-17-19-20**) sts.

Cont even until armhole measures same length as Back, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off.

With RS of work facing, join yarn to rem sts and cast off next 35 (**35-35-35-39-39-39**) sts. Knit to end of row.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 5 rows, then every following alt row 3 times. 12 (**13-14-17-17-19-20**) sts.

Cont even until armhole measures same length as Back, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off.

**SLEEVES**

\*\*With A and larger needles, cast on 42 sts.

Knit 3 rows. Break A.

Change to smaller needles, MC and proceed as follows:

**Next row:** (K1. Inc 1 st in next st) 6 times. (Inc 1 st in next st) 18 times. (Inc 1 st in next st. K1) 6 times. 72 sts.

Beg with a purl row, cont in stocking st, inc 1 st each end of needle on 21st and every following 10th row to 78 (**84-90-96-102-104-108**) sts.

Cont even until Sleeve from beg measures 17 (**18-18½-18½-18½-18½-18½**) ins [45 (**45.5-47-47-47-47-47**) cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

**Shape Top:** Cast off 3 (**5-6-6-7-7-8**) sts beg next 2 rows. 72 (**74-78-84-88-90-92**) sts.

Dec 1 st each end of needle on next and every following alt row to 44 (**40-40-42-46-40-40**) sts, then every row to 12 (**12-12-14-14-16-16**) sts. Cast off.

**Neck edging:** Sew right shoulder seam. With RS of work facing, larger needles and A, pick up and knit 21 sts down left front neck edge, 20 (**20-20-20-23-23-23**) sts across front neck edge, 21 sts up right front neck edge, 30 (**30-30-30-36-36-36**) sts across back neck edge. 92 (**92-92-92-101-101-101**) sts. Cast off knitwise (WS).

**FINISHING**

Pin garment pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Sew left shoulder seam and neck edging seam. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.
