Skill Level 2: Easy

ABBREVIATIONS: **approx** = approximately; **beg** = begin(ning); **CA** = Color A; **CB** = Color B; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **pat(s)** = pattern(s); **rem** = remaining; **rep** = repeat; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarn over needle; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * **or** ** = repeat whatever follows the * **or** ** as indicated.

Scarf measures 40 (44, 48)" without fringe.

SUPPLIES

TLC "Cotton Plus", Art. E516, (3.5 oz/178 yard ball): 2 balls No. 3001 White **CA**, 1 ball each No. 3907 Red **CB**, 3222 Yellow **CC**, 3811 Blue **CD**, 3252 Orange **CE**.

Option 2: 2 balls No. 3859 Navy **CA** and 1 ball No. 3907 Red **CB**.

Option 3: 2 balls No. 3002 Black

Crochet Hook: 4 mm [US G-6].
1 Package Ring Dings (25 assorted rings) per pack.
Yarn Needle.

GAUGE: 12 rows = 4"; 16 sts = 4" in pat. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**
Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

With **CA**, ch 163 (181, 193). **Row 1 (Right Side):** Sc in second ch from hook, dc next ch, * sc next ch, dc in next ch; rep from * across; turn - 162 (180, 192) sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, * sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from * across, turn.

Rows 3-4: Rep Row 2 for pat, changing to **CB** in last st; turn.

Row 5: Rep Row 2, randomly placing 5 rings as follows: insert hook through ring, insert hook through next st, yo, pull through st and ring, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook, changing to **CA** in last st; turn.

Row 6: Rep Row 2, changing to **CC** in last st; turn.

Row 7: Rep Row 5.

Row 8: Rep Row 2, changing to **CD** in last st; turn.

Row 9: Rep Row 5.

Row 10: Rep Row 2, changing to **CE** in last st; turn.

Row 11: Rep Row 5.

Row 12: Rep Row 2, changing to **CB** in last st; turn.

Row 13: Rep Row 5.

Rows 14-17: Rep Row 2.

Fasten off.

Fringe: Cut 16" strands of each color for fringe. Fold strands in half to form a loop, insert hook from wrong side into fabric near other ends and draw loop through the fabric, then draw all ends of fringe and those from row ends through the loop. Tighten. Trim.
